RE: Golf Course Violations

When the New Course was opened, it was announced that all carts must stay on the cart paths. This is also told to golfers when they check in, and signage to this effect is prominently displayed.

All golfers should understand that this rule was implemented because of the stress to the fairways, and even in dry conditions carts will severely damage our fairways.

The vast majority of golfers have abided by this rule; however, there are some who choose to ignore it. The Board has responded with the following penalties for violations to the Cart Path Only rule:

For the first violation of the Cart Path Only rule, the golfer will receive a warning from the Pro Shop.

For a second violation of the Cart Path Only rule, the golfer will have his playing privileges suspended for seven days.

For a subsequent violation of the Cart Path Only rule, the golfer will have his playing privileges suspended for thirty days.

Any additional violations will be subject to additional thirty-day suspensions or other actions to be determined by the Board.

Carts will be allowed to leave the cart paths on the non-fairway side and within five feet of the cart path on the fairway side, but under no circumstances are they permitted on the fairways.
