We want to make everyone aware once again that there will be no fireworks display on Saturday, July 1st. Mike Ward refused to pay for DD's 50% sharing of the cost. Your POA Board agreed unanimously to pay 100% of the cost. Mike Ward then refused to allow the POA to have access to the strip of land beside the Marina, which is where the fireworks have always been ignited. Double Diamond leases this land from the Corps. I spoke directly with the Corps, and they confirmed that Double Diamond can refuse us access to that land. We are indeed sorry that Mike Ward has chosen this path.

We have also announced an alternative event that will be a real celebration of the holiday! The POA is hosting an Independence Day Celebration on the parking lot of the Cascade Pool across from the Lighthouse Restaurant. The air-conditioned Lone Star Room will be open, and tables with shade canopies will be set up outside. The nationally famous, eight-piece dance/show band, IDENTITY CRISIS, will be playing for our Street Dance that will begin at 7:00 PM. Property owners and guests are free to bring their own food and beverages of choice. The Cascade Pool will be open, but no glass or alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the pool area.
