RE: Golf Carts, ATVs and other motorized vehicles

At the POA Board Meeting held on Saturday, July 20th the Board passed new rules regarding golf carts, ATVs and all other motorized vehicles driven on White Bluff roads. This action was taken because of the preponderance of vehicles and obvious safety factors. Security will begin enforcing the following rules immediately:

The vehicle must have a universal “Slow Moving Vehicle” sign attached to the back of it, and it must be easily seen by approaching traffic.

The vehicle must be equipped with a rear view mirror.

The driver of the vehicle is to yield to traffic approaching from behind by moving off the road when it is safe to do so.

Vehicles should be driven on low usage streets as much as possible. White Bluff Drive and Golf Drive should be avoided as much as possible.

The driver of the vehicle must have a current automobile driver’s license and be at least sixteen (16) years of age.

The vehicle may be carrying no more passengers than the designated number of seats available.

Vehicles may be operated only during full daylight hours, unless they are equipped with functional headlights and taillights.

Persons who violate these rules may be ticketed and fined by the White Bluff Security Department. If the driver is a minor, the responsible adult property owner will be ticketed and fined.
