RE: Feral Hogs

**ATTENTION  
VERY IMPORTANT!**

We have received reports and have evidence that Feral Hogs are on White Bluff property. The assumption is they are entering the property from Steiner Ranch and are attracted to the deer corn many property owners are using to attract deer.

Anyone who has seen the news regarding these animals is aware that they cause massive destruction. They breed three times a year and birth litters of eleven or more. The “new” hogs are breeding before they turn one year old.

At last Saturday’s Board Meeting, all in attendance were asked to cease feeding deer with deer corn immediately. Feral Hogs are attracted to deer corn and can smell its presence from long distances away.

The Board will be discussing this situation in detail in a Work Session on Friday.

**We are asking that all property owners stop feeding deer immediately regardless of the type or brand. This request is being made whether you are using a deer feeder or feeding deer by putting food out for them. The hogs will come!**

There is a multitude of deer naturally roaming our property that can be enjoyed without attracting them with feed.
