RE: Proposed Rate Increase for WB Water/Sewage Services

Yesterday all property owners received an email from the Board regarding filing a protest (against) Double Diamond Utilities' proposed (45%) rate increase. This communication incorrectly went out to all property owners. Please accept my apology for any confusion caused by this mistake. **If you are not a WB homeowner, this rate increase does NOT apply to you. If you are a WB homeowner, this rate increase does.**

Only WB homeowners with water and (or) sewage services provided by Double Diamond Utilities are affected. If you only own property in WB no action is needed from you.

For the convenience of our homeowners who wish to file a protest, there are two attachments to this email communication. The first is a copy of the correspondence you should have received from Double Diamond Utilities. The second is a copy of (the) Rate Protest form. Click on the link in the lower left of the page to access these attachments.

If you wish to protest this (45%) rate increase, (and we hope you do,) please complete the form and take it to the POA office in the Administration Building. If you have already mailed the protest form to Austin, please complete a second form and take it to the POA office. Our intent is to file these with the PUC in mass, and we also need to know the number of protests we have. Yvonne will make the ten copies required by the PUC.

Again, I apologize about the confusion. A committee is being formed, and additional appropriate action has already begun by your Board as well as interested homeowners.
