RE: Water/Sewage Rate Increase

Your response in filing rate increase protests has been fantastic! However, in a situation like this there is definitely strength in numbers.

There are approximately 640 homes in White Bluff that are affected by Double Diamond's request for a rate increase. The state dictated minimum of 10% to have a hearing before the Public Utilities Commission has been met, but we need even greater numbers to illustrate to the PUC that we believe this request is unfounded and exorbitant. **Our goal is a MINIMUM of one-half of our homeowners!**

Here's what you can do-

1. If you haven't completed the protest form, do so immediately and take it to the POA office in the Administration Building. Yvonne will make the required 10 copies for you.
2. If you have filed your protest form, make a **minimum** of 5 phone calls to friends, acquaintances and neighbors. Ask them if they have completed the form and, if not, encourage or even offer to assist them in doing so.
3. Think about whom you may know that might have difficulty in completing the form or who might overlook it. Call them and offer to help!
4. Think about homeowners who either don't use email or who don't have their email address recorded with the POA. Call them and offer to help!

Together we can fight this. Do your part today!
