RE: POA Alternative to Closed Burn Pit

As you are aware, the Burn Pit has been closed and rendered inaccessible to property owners who wish to deposit burnable trash there. Beginning Saturday, January 6th the POA will have two employees and a chipper located at the grounds maintenance area behind the Administration Building between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM. Property owners can bring tree limbs and other forms of brush to this location, and the POA employees will run them through the chipper and dispose of the mulch. Branches must be a manageable size and no greater than 12 inches in diameter.

This service is free of charge and will continue on the first Saturday of every month. Its continuation is subject to property owner demand and until the Burn Pit has been reopened. Property owners who wish to have some of the mulch are free to do so during the above stated hours.

Your POA Board will continue in its efforts to try to provide solutions to the issues we are facing.
